A walking tour led by Callum Cintron of the BCT.


SHORT TOUR LAYOUT. Start and end will be the Rail Trail Parking, Plain Rd, Wayland, MA 01778

2.25 mi each way - 4.5mi total 2.5 hours

Our walk will begin at the Rail Trail Parking lot in Wayland. From there we will head northbound on the Bay Circuit Trail (BCT) to the Cow Common Reservation.

Cow Common is 72.1 acres of open fields with red maple swamp mixed in throughout the southwest corner of the property that borders the river. There we will spend 45 minutes learning about the diversity of birds

that call the Reservation home from Wayland's Conservation Department Staffers. To conclude we will walk back to the Rail Trail Parking lot.
